WHY TO REPORT?

- Enhances patient safety
- Enhances Pharmacovigilance
- Informs medication labelling and guidelines
- Support public health initiatives

WHO SHOULD REPORT?

- Healthcare Professionals
- Patients
- Caregivers
- Pharmacists



WHAT TO REPORT?

- Patient Information
- Medication Information
- Signs and Symptoms
- Severity and duration
- Lab investigations

HOW TO REPORT?

- **Helpline:** Call toll-free number **1800-180-3024** from 9 AM to 5:30 PM on working days.
- **Form:** Fill out suspected ADR form and mail to pvpi@ipcindia.net or ipclab@vsnl.net.
- **Mobile app:** Use the **ADR PvPI app**, on Playstore
- **Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring Centre (AMC):** Visit the nearest AMC.
